So far, **3,816** applications worth **\$9,332M** have been reviewed by OIP (3+4+5+6+7), of which 3,379 (88.5 per cent) worth \$6,671 (71.5 per cent) were cleared and moved to the next processing stage (4+5+6+7), and 437 (11.4% per cent) valued at \$2,661M (28.5 per cent) await response to request for clarifications (3).

So far, **3,087** applications worth \$6,241M have been reviewed by UNMOVIC/IAEA (5+6+7), of which 1,708 (55.3 per cent) worth \$2,287M (36.6 per cent) contained no GRL items and were approved by OIP (6), 1,284 (41.6 per cent) worth \$3,872M (62 per cent) await response to requests for additional technical information (5), and 95 (3.1 per cent) worth \$182M (2.9 per cent) contained one or more GRL items (7).

Most of the applications determined by OIP as Non-Compliant lack detailed lists of the contract's spare parts/tools/sets/kits, or require clarification on service component. In the category of applications determined as GRL Non-Compliant, UNMOVIC had additional questions in 1,158 cases (90.2 per cent), IAEA alone requested additional information in 29 cases (2.2 per cent), and both UNMOVIC and IAEA had additional questions in 95 cases (7.4 per cent).
