Most of the **OIP Non-Compliant** comms lack detail lists of spare parts/tools/sets/kits or require clarification on payment terms and service components.

Of comms that are or have been **GRL Non-Compliant**, only UNMOVIC had additional questions in 107 cases (87%), only IAEA in 9 cases (7.3%) and in 7 cases both UNMOVIC and IAEA had additional questions (5.7%).
