## **GENERAL UPDATE ON HOLDS**

## 5 September 2001

As of 5 September 2001, there were 1,505 applications on hold worth US\$3.802M. That level of holds represents 15.8% of all applications circulated to the 661 Sanctions Committee or 12.4% of all applications circulated to the Committee AND notified by the Secretariat.

Chart I shows changes in the level of holds for the past year. The general trend is upwards, with occasional decreases resulting either from the release of large number of applications from hold at the same time (as in June 2001) or the release of several high-value applications during the same week (like in July 2001). It should be noted that, although the absolute value of holds keeps going up, the relative size of holds has gone up very slowly. In the last two weeks, the number of holds decreased slightly, but only because a number of contracts on hold were cancelled at the request of the Government of Iraq.

Table 1 shows the status of applications as of 5 September 2001, all sectors and all phases. The highest percentage of holds is in Water and Sanitation, with 31.3% (29.3) of the applications for that sector currently on hold. The next two sectors are Electricity, with 27.3% (27.3), and Education, with 25.5% (21.7). There are no holds in the Food Basket sector as all applications are notified by the Secretariat; in contrast, the Special Allocation sector, with only 7 applications, has all of them on hold at the moment. The lowest level of holds are to be found in the Housing, Food handling and Agriculture sectors, with 7.6% (6.5), 12.6% (12) and 16.6% (15) respectively.

Tables 2 and 3 provide a breakdown of applications on hold, grouped according to the reason given for the hold.

A total of 651 applications are on hold for technical and other kinds of information, including end-use and end-user specifications. It is the largest group, comprising 43% of the holds. The next group is the one including 531 applications on hold because they contain goods on the 1051 list. The next major category, accounting for 12% of the holds, is the WMD dual use, or simply "dual use" reason, which has increased lately. These are the three main categories of holds, and they are further broken down in Table 3. For example, in spite of OIP efforts to provide detailed explanations and clarifications, there are still 211 applications on hold where the 1051 assessment between the Secretariat and the Committee members' experts differs. Table 3 also breaks down the main category, which is the request for additional information, mainly technical specifications. This category, as noted, comprises 651 applications. Of that number, information has been provided to the holder missions for 282 of those applications and they still remain on hold while we wait for some feedback from the holding missions.

Table 4 provides further details on all the holds from another point of view. In the first two categories, additional information has been requested (whatever the main reason for hold was). In the first column, no such

information has been provided despite the fact that it might lift the hold. The second column shows 415 applications for which information has been forwarded, but which remain on hold. The last group of 583 applications remains on hold for various reasons, but reason does not include any request for information.
