TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY FIFTH REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990) CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAQ AND KUWAIT

The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

1. During the reporting period, 29 December 2001 to 4 January 2002, 13 new contracts were approved. (For details see, table 1)

2. In accordance with paragraphs 12 and 13 of the Procedures, 3 letters of credit and amendments for 3 liftings were confirmed by the Overseers.

3. Nine loadings, (6 from Mina-al-Bakr, 3 from Ceyhan), comprising 15.5 million barrels, (9.3 from Mina-al-Bakr, 6.2 from Ceyhan) with an estimated value of Euro 305 million were completed (\$275 million at current rate of exchange).

4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase XI at current prices is estimated at about Euro 876 million (\$788 million at current rate of exchange).

5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$17.7/bbl or Euro 19.6/bbl.

6. The trading window for Europe is second half January. Deals for Europe were reported at a premia in the mid to high 30 4/bbl above the OSP. The trading window for the US/West is for late January loaders. Offers of 35 4/bbl above the OSP were reported for this period. No deals were reported for the Far East.

OBSERVATIONS

3.1 MINA AL-BAKR

Mooring Boats/Tugs

No mooring boats on station at the terminal. Tugs "TAJ AL MARAK", "ALTAHADY" and new tugs "FATTEH AL MOBEEN" and "ALRAYIAH" on stand-by.

NOTE 1: Same as previous week

On platform A pier 1 the FW wood fender is 40% missing, and the AFT fender is also 30% missing. Pier 2 the fenders are good. On platform B pier 3 the fenders must be checked. Pier 4 the FW fender is with 30% missing, and the AFT fender is also 40% missing.

Power

Some power cuts during this week (Once a day, for short periods). Generators are working on alternating basis. The generators were tested and until now no major problems were reported.

Transport to / from terminal

Only tug boats used for transportation of personnel to Fao or Umm Kasr.

Passenger-boat out of order.

Relief schedule is on Saturday (pilots), Sunday and Wednesday, but schedule is unreliable.

The passenger-boat is used only after the 'Crane' (near Kor-al-Amaya), and tugs used for Fao are restricted to pass the river bar at high tide and sometimes only at daylight high tide.

Main effect of this is that personnel due out on rotation leave the terminal 4/5 days earlier than would normally be necessary, in order to assure they can meet their travel/flight schedules.

Reliability of scheduled service is further hampered by unstable weather conditions.

Safety aspects are also heightened, particularly when personnel transfer 'boat to boat' or 'boat to terminal'. The two tugs draw alongside and there is a scramble across.

No safety provisions, and sometimes in very dangerous and unstable weather conditions.

No safe gangway or means of access available at either shore or terminal location for staff to embark or disembark. Increasing need to transfer from tug to tug and tug to MAB terminal.

Safety considerations: NIL.

Services

The Water supply this week was without problem. Now we have luke warm and cold water, and quality found to be acceptable, except for the purpose of drinking. Some discoloration detected. The new R.O.Unit is working without problems.

NOTE 2 : This problem continues without solution as previous week

The Water Storage tank as soon as possible must be cleaned, because sometimes the water is discoloured. (Perhaps not only the Water Storage tank but some oldpipes especially the hot water pipes must be replaced)

NOTE 3: Some parts of the old one still remained at MAB.

Potable bottled water is still in supply.

Food

====

Terminal food this week improved a little bit, they supplied fresh fruit and some fresh vegetables. (The variety increase is not too much, but the fruit and vegetable are fresh).

All UN staff meals are made by us, or self-catering on board vessels.

Housekeeping

Standard of cleanliness remains moderate.

Excessive outside oil.

During this week the outside oil remained moderate; also constant lack of sufficient water doesn't make it easy to keep the interior clean. Some repairs on the roof and paintings and cleaning of rust were made outside the accommodation.

Infestation

Insect population is still evident, through decreasing or increasing due to ambient temperatures. No de-infestation carried out this week. Although Saybolt accommodations is kept clean and sprayed regularly by Saybolt staff, insects as cockroaches are still present (but decreasing) in living room and Saybolt rooms.

Safety

At this moment the installation of platforms (launch davits) for two life-boats near the accommodations, is completed stopped. The two Life-Boats are at this moment positioned at Platform B.

NOTE 4 : During this week the work restarted again and they are trying to finished with the installation of launch devits, and replace the water fire pipe.Until now the work goes slowly.

The Lights are being checked and changed/replaced regularly. No accidents.

Refer to numerous previous reports over the last years concerning Fire and Safety, no fire drill or safety exercises observed this week. It needs to be stated here & on every report, that there seems to be no local contingency plan for emergencies such as outbreak of fire, serious illness or accidents to staff. Indeed any type of local plan to deal with various emergencies remains unknown to us.

NOTE: The gangway of Platform B (pier 3) is not working properly; sometimes it's very dangerous to use (high tide & vsl not commenced ldng /lo tide & vls completed ldng). The gangway of Platform B (pier 4) is with problems again. For the moment the gangway is working, until when we don't know.

Environmental conditions

TERMINAL GARBAGE AND WASTE CONTINUES TO BE DISPOSED OF INTO THE SEA. LUB. OIL WASTE FROM GENERATORS DUMPED TO SEA REGULARLY.

Other remarks

The relationship between Saybolt/UN staff and local terminal personnel remains very good.

Hydraulic leaks

Hydraulic leaks from gangways and pump units for operating the loading arms continues. During this week some efforts were made to fix this problem, but the lack of spare parts difficult the operation. Situation same as previous week, Oil spill is collected for refilling but surroundings affected by spill. Sawdust received from vessels alongside used to prevent spreading of spills, implication to safety of personnel. Some of the leaking of Hydraulic oil can be repaired if they have spare parts to change, also if the leaking of oil into the platform were collected with sand and after removed to drums.

On Platform A the Crane now is operational.

NOTE 5: Loading Arms

On the platform A pier n.2 the 2nd Loading arm is already repaired. On the platform B pier n.3 the 2nd/3rd Loading arm is already repaired.
