

**THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY EIGHT REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO  
THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990)  
CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAQ AND KUWAIT**

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The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

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1. During the reporting period, 15 to 21 March 2003, 1 new contract was approved. (For details see, table1).
2. No letters of credit or amendments were confirmed by the Overseers.
3. Three loadings, (1 from Mina-al-Bakr, 2 from Ceyhan), comprising 3.1 million barrels, (2.0 from Mina-al-Bakr, 1.1 from Ceyhan) with an estimated value of Euro 60 million were completed (\$63 million at current rate of exchange).
4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase XIII at current prices is estimated at about Euro 4,175 million (\$4,413 million at current rate of exchange).
5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$22.00/bbl or Euro 20.80/bbl.

<b>General</b>	<b>Umm Qasr evacuated on 17.March. Trebil, Al Waleed, Arrar, Zakho on 18.March 2003.</b>
<b>Al-Waleed</b>	Very busy until the evacuation day - 18.March. It coincided with heavy traffic of wheat and team remain all night awoken, preparing for the evacuation. Data shift continued duty until replication time 03:30 to finish as much as possible of due authentications. Departed 08:30 from the site.
<b>Trebil</b>	Traffic steady until evacuation date - 18.March. Average number of authentication 412 per day. The whole team arrived Amman in morning hours on 18.March.
<b>Umm Qasr</b>	No data available for this week. Team evacuated via UNIKOM and Kuwait on 17.March. Landed Amman on 19.March from Kuwait City.



<b>In Zakho</b>	No data available for this week. Team evacuated via Turkey on 18.March. Final arrival in Amman on 21.March 12:30. Lot of flights get re-routed and cancelled to /from Amman airport.
