THREE HUNDRED AND SECOND REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990) CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAO AND KUWAIT

The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

- 1. During the reporting period, 14 to 20 September 2002, 7 new contracts were approved. (For details see, table 1).
- 2. In accordance with paragraphs 12 and 13 of the Procedures, 18 letters of credit and amendments for 16 liftings were confirmed by the Overseers.
- 3. Nine loadings, (4 from Ceyhan, 5 from Mina-al-Bakr), comprising 13.3 million barrels, (4.4 from Ceyhan, 8.9 from Mina-al-Bakr) with an estimated value of Euro 351 million were completed (\$344 million at current rate of exchange).
- 4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase XII at current prices is estimated at about Euro 2,770 million (\$2,712 million at current rate of exchange).
- 5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$25.7/bbl or Euro 26.4/bbl.
- 6. All deals done during the period have been reported at premia around 5 cents per barrel for all destinations. SOMO has recently awarded direct contracts to a number of end-users. In these cases there are no intermediaries involved and the oil is therefore purchased at no premia over the OSP.
