# TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY SECOND REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990) CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAQ AND KUWAIT

The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

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- 1. During the reporting period, 29 September to 5 October 2001, 2 new contracts were approved. (For details see, table 1)
- 2. In accordance with paragraphs 12 and 13 of the Procedures, 16 letters of credit and amendments for 14 liftings were confirmed by the Overseers.
- 3. Twelve loadings, (7 from Mina-al-Bakr, 5 from Ceyhan), comprising 18.0 million barrels, (12.0 from Mina-al-Bakr, 6.0 from Ceyhan) with an estimated value of Euro 357 million were completed (\$328 million at current rate of exchange).
- 4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase X at current prices is estimated at about Euro 3,935 million (\$3,616 million at current rate of exchange).
- 5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$18.20/bbl or Euro 19.85/bbl.
- 6. The assessment of Market premia is the following: The current trading window for the <u>Far East destination</u> is for November loadings. Sellers are still asking premia of at least \$0.40/bbl above the OSP. There is no evidence that buyers are willing to pay this and no deals were reported for this destination. Also for the <u>US destination</u> there seems to be stand off situation. Sellers demand premia of at least \$0.40/barrel. With the uncertainty around the OSP setting process, buyers seem to refuse to pay these. No deals were reported for this destination either. The trading window for <u>Europe</u> destined crude oil is for the second half of October. Sellers' asking premia are similar to the ones as for the Far East and for the USA. In the current economic environment most buyers cannot afford to pay these and no deals were reported during the course of last week.

*Terminal Manning*; Terminal fully manned (ca. 80 people)

Mooring Boats/Tugs; No mooring boats on station at the terminal.

Tugs "TAJ AL MARAK", "ALTAHADY", "FATTEH AL MOBEEN" and "AL RAYIAH" on stand-by.

*Power*; Several power cuts daily this week; generators are working on alternating basis.

*Transport to / from terminal*; The tender No. 366 is out of service.

*Services*; The new R/O is in function ok. Water is rather discoloured (brownish). Only cold water is supplied. Bottled water is potable and still in supply.

*Food*; Terminal food continues to be of extremely poor quality. Meals served are bad, however, some improvement has been observed. Fruit and vegetables were fresh. All UN staff meals self-catering or on board vessels.

Housekeeping; Standard of cleanliness remains moderate to poor.

*Infestation*; No de-infestation carried out this week. In spite of Saybolt staff carrying out regular de-infestation in both living and sleeping accommodation areas, cockroaches are ever present; Presence even in the beds.

*Safety*; No accidents. No fire drill or safety exercises observed this week. No local contingency plan for emergencies such as outbreak of fire, serious illness or accidents to staff.

The supplied Life Boats remain stored on Platform B. The construction of the launch davits necessary for the Life Boats are still not completed, and has been suspended from December 2000. *Environmental conditions*; Terminal garbage, waste and used lubricating oil continues to be disposed of directly into the sea. Gangways and pumps are leaking excessive quantities of hydraulic oil resulting in very slippery conditions at the platforms. Sand or sawdust to clean up the oil is to be received from the vessels: no stock on the island.

*Other remarks*; The relationship between Saybolt/UN staff and local terminal personnel is good. Gangway at berth 3 has broken down and replaced by an incorrect one. Repair of the original takes some time as it is an aluminium construction. There are also some hydraulic problems at the loading-arm at berth 3.

**Pumping rate:** Average pumping rate during this week was: 72,000 barrels/hr
