THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY FIFTH REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990) CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAQ AND KUWAIT

The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

- 1. During the reporting period, 5 to 11 October 2002, 7 new contracts were approved. (For details see, table 1)
- 2. In accordance with paragraphs 12 and 13 of the Procedures, 9 letters of credit and amendments for 7 liftings were confirmed by the Overseers.
- 3. Four loadings, (1 from Mina-al-Bakr, 3 from Ceyhan), comprising 4.1 million barrels, (1.0 from Mina-al-Bakr, 3.1 from Ceyhan) with an estimated value of Euro 107 million were completed (\$105 million at current rate of exchange.
- 4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase XII at current prices is estimated at about Euro3,367 million (\$3,300 million at current rate of exchange).
- 5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$25.70/bbl or Euro 26.10/bbl.
- 6. There is no change to last week's assessment which reads as follows: "All deals done during the period have been reported at premia around 5 cents per barrel for all destinations. SOMO has recently awarded direct contracts to a number of endusers. In these cases there are no intermediaries involved and the oil is therefore purchased at no premia over the OSP".
