THREE HUNDRED AND ELEVENTH REPORT OF THE OVERSEERS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION 661 (1990) CONCERNING THE SITUATION BETWEEN IRAQ AND KUWAIT

The following report is submitted to the Security Council Committee established by resolution 661 (1990) concerning the situation between Iraq and Kuwait pursuant to paragraph 14 of the Committee Procedures, by which the Overseers were required to submit a weekly report to the Committee on the contracts considered by them with regard to sale of petroleum and petroleum products originating in Iraq, including the cumulative quantity and approximate value of petroleum authorized for export.

- 1. During the reporting period, 16 to 22 November 2002, 1 new contract was approved. (For details see, table 1)
- 2. In accordance with paragraphs 12 and 13 of the Procedures, 16 letters of credit and amendments for 14 liftings were confirmed by the Overseers.
- 3. Twelve loadings, (6 from Mina-al-Bakr, 6 from Ceyhan), comprising 17.1 million barrels, (10.9 from Mina-al-Bakr, 6.2 from Ceyhan) with an estimated value of Euro 363 million were completed (\$365 million at current rate of exchange.)
- 4. The revenue generated from the beginning of Phase XII at current prices is estimated at about Euro 5,067 million (\$5,079 million at current rate of exchange).
- 5. The average price for Iraqi crude during the reporting period was approximately \$21.40/bbl or Euro 21.25/bbl.
- 6. The situation concerning the premia for Iraqi crude oil has normalized since September 2002. The oil overseers will immediately report to the Committee if any abnormal developments occur.
